Essential qualifications for appointed public representatives Include

- Knowledge of, and interest in midwifery in Manitoba;
- Willingness to support the CMM in regulating the profession to protect the public;
- Sensitivity to issues of culture and equity; and
- Familiarity with consensus decision-making.

(\*Appointed Public Representatives may not be members of another regulated health care profession in Manitoba).
